

3013 Bug Fix: Microsoft Security Bulletin MS05-054 Cumulative Security Update for Internet Explorer (905915) Leads to GIF Display Problems in HTML

Applies to: Net Report Versions 4.0 and greater and DataSet Vision Versions 3.20.02 and earlier.

Symptoms

Image files in GIF (Graphic Interchange Format) format are not displayed in Dashboards and Reports generated and viewed in HTML format via the Net Report Web Portal and/or DataSet Vision.

Cause

DataSet Vision exports certain image files in GIF format when running a report in HTML format via the web, for example HTML format Dashboards and reports generated and viewed via the Net Report Web Portal and DataSet Vision. The latest Microsoft Security Bulletin MS05-054 Cumulative Security Update for Internet Explorer (905915) prevents these GIF format image files from being displayed in HTML format via Internet Explorer.



Temporary Workaround


To temporarily resolve this problem apply the following workaround. Remove the Microsoft Security Bulletin MS05-054 Cumulative Security Update for Internet Explorer (905915) to fix this problem. To do so please follow the steps below.

Steps

1. Select **Start> Control Panel> Add or Remove Programs.**
2. Wait for the list of currently installed programs to appear.
3. Select **Security Update for Windows XP (KB905915).**



4. Click **Remove**. The **Software Update Removal Wizard** appears.



5. Click **Next>**.

Note: removing the Security Update KB905915 may stop certain programs functioning correctly.

6. Restart your computer when the Software Update Remove Wizard has terminated.
