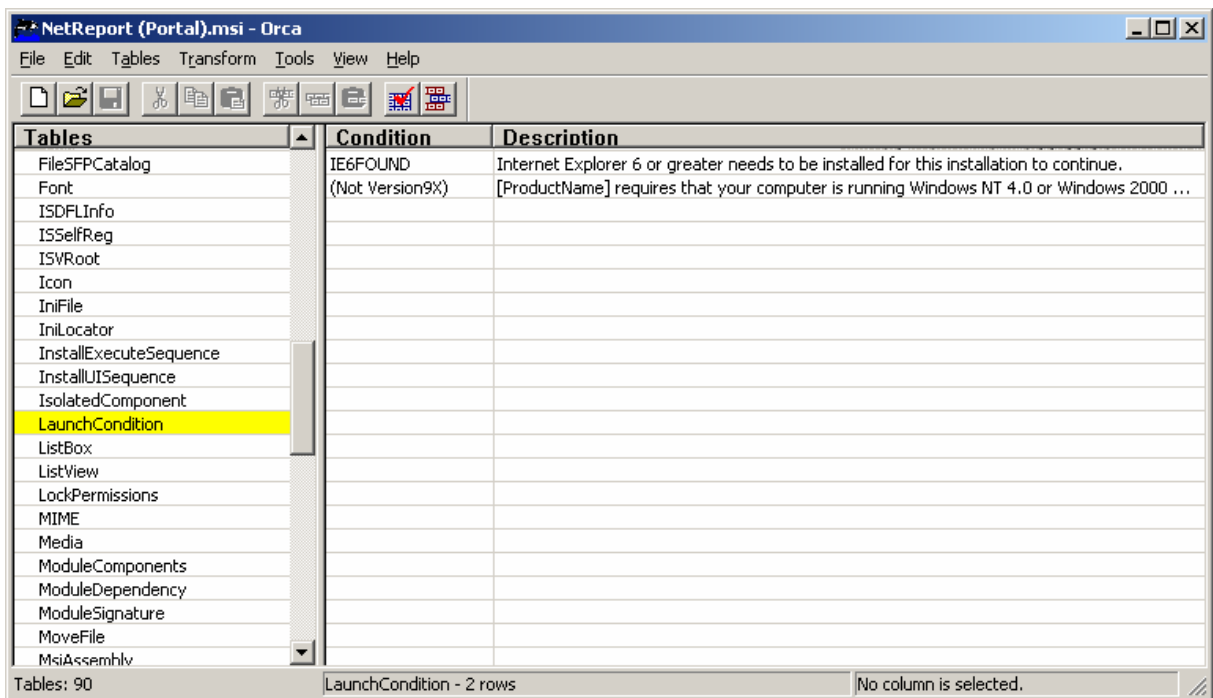
Steps

1. Decide which Net Report solution you want to install. **How? ▾**
In the Net Report setup directory the solutions are listed as follows:



NET REPORT

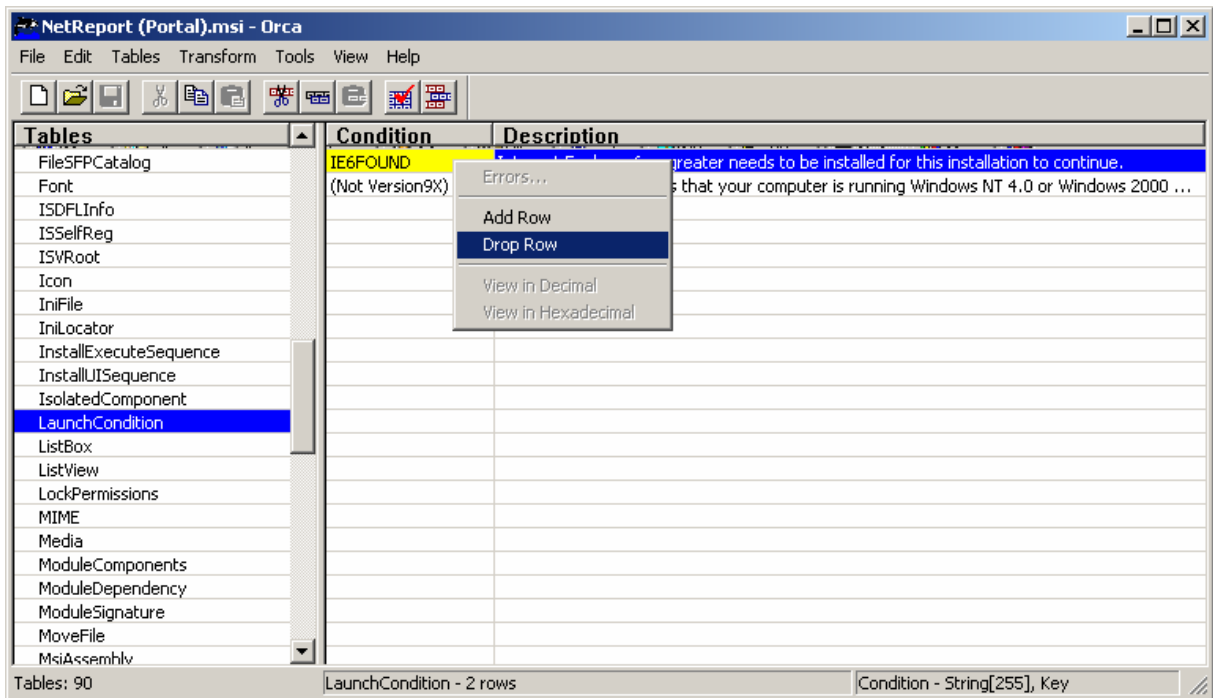
- **all** directory: contains Net_Report.msi: the complete Net Report Solution.
 - **console** directory: contains Net_Report(Management Console).msi : only the Net Report Management Console.
 - **engine** directory: contains Net_Report(Engine).msi for the Net Report Engine without the Web Portal.
 - **portal** directory: contains Net_Report(Portal).msi for the Net Report Web Portal only.
2. Launch Orca.exe to edit a Net_Report[Solution Name].msi.
 3. Select the setup directory where Net Report has been installed.
 4. Select **File> Open...**
 5. Open the *.msi file at:
c:\..\Master_NR[Version Number]\setup\ Net_Report [Solution Name].msi.
The NetReport[Solution Name).msi opens.
 6. Select the LaunchCondition table from the Left **Tables** Pane. **Show Me!**



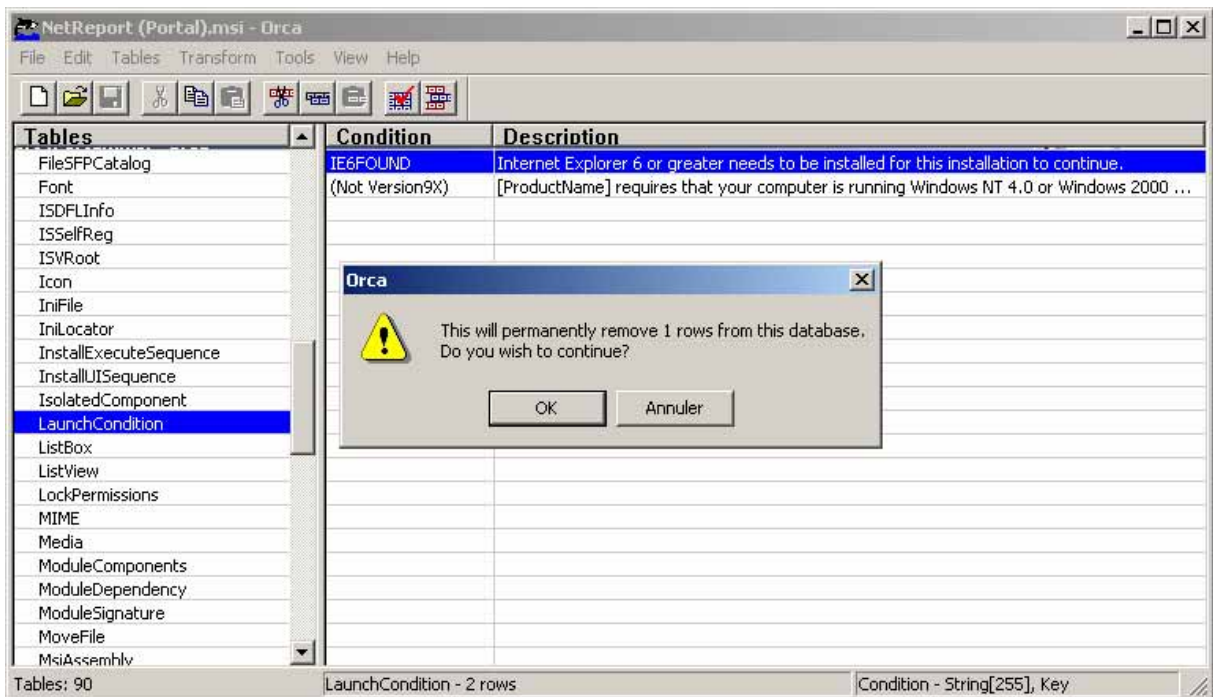
7. Right-click on the **IE6FOUND Condition** line. The context menu appears.
8. Click **Drop Row** in the context menu to remove the **IE6FOUND Condition** line from the **Condition** pane. **Show Me!**

9. Click **OK** in the **This will permanently remove 1 row from this database. Do you wish to continue?** message. **Show Me!**



The **IE6FOUND** line will be dropped.

10. Select **File>Save** to save the changes you have made.



Editing the setup.ini file

Steps

1. Select **Start > All Programs > Accessories > Notepad** (or another text editor).
2. Select **File > Open...**
3. Open:
c:\..\Master_NR[Version Number]\setup> Net Report [Solution Name]>
setup.ini.
The setup.ini file opens.
4. Search for the entry: MsiVersion=2.0.2600.0 in the Startup section. **Show Me!**



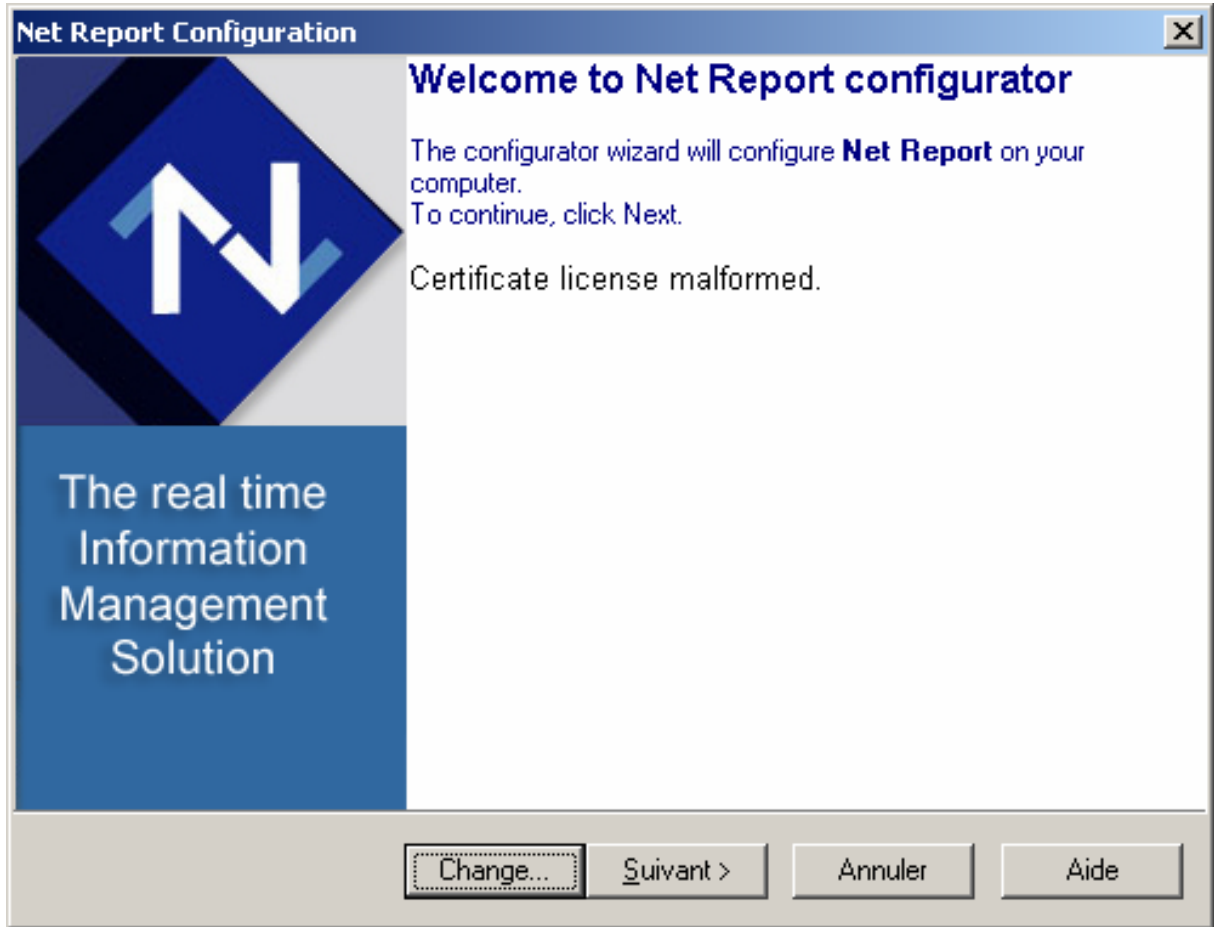

Running setup.exe

Steps

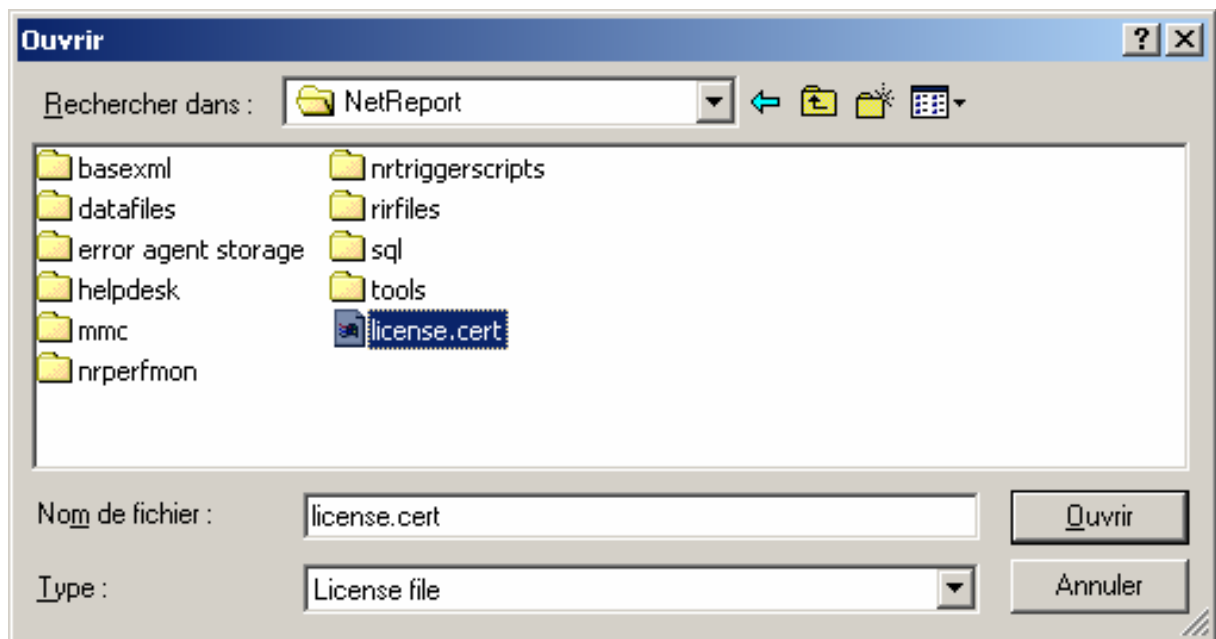
1. Find:
`c:\..\Master_NR[Version Number]> setup> Net Report[Solution Name]> setup.exe.`
2. Double-click on `setup.exe`. The **Net Report [Solution Name] InstallShield Wizard** opens. The Malformed License Certificate message will appear. **Show Me!**



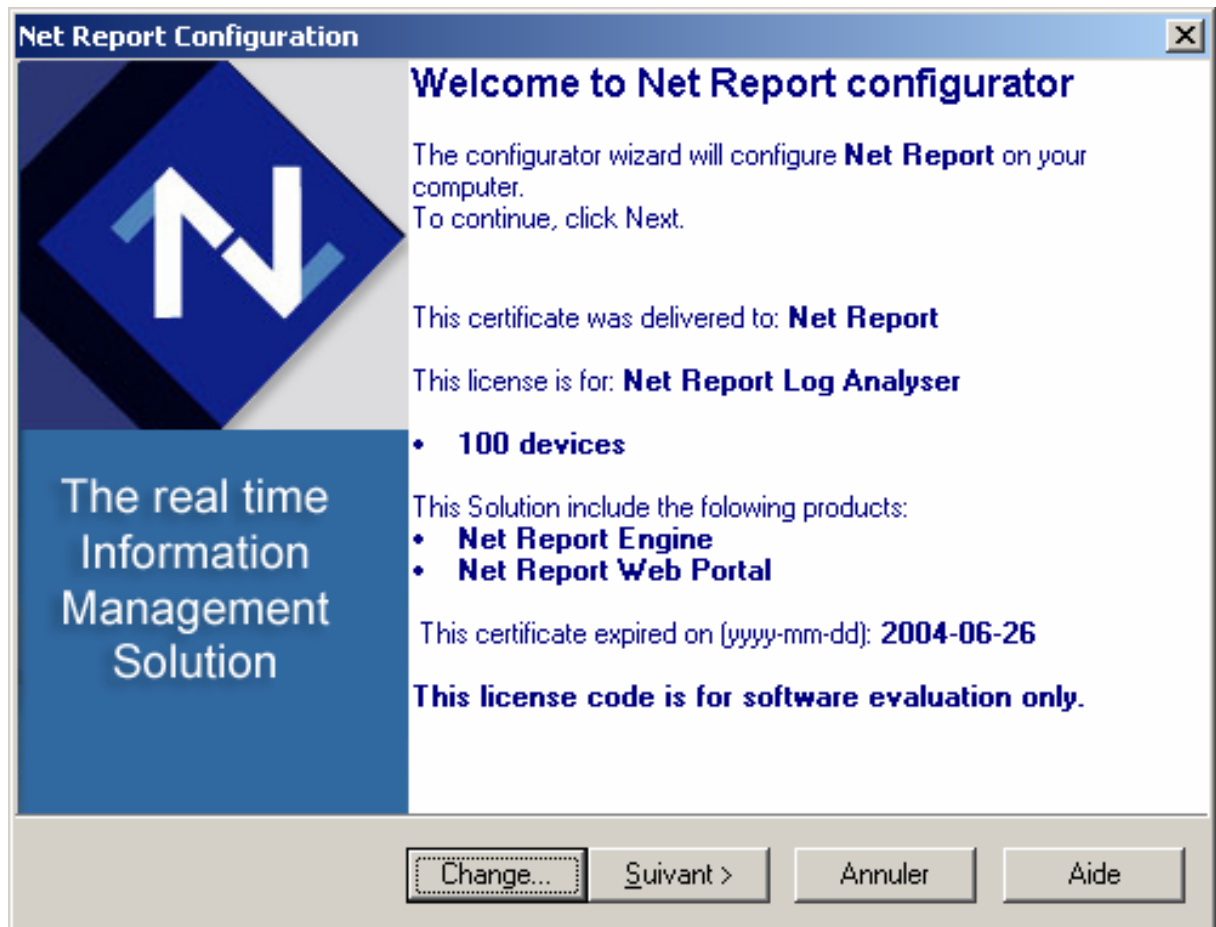
3. Click **Change...** to locate the `license.cert` at:
`c:\..\Master_NR[Version Number]> license.cert. Show Me!`

4. Click **Open**. The **Welcome to Net Report Configurator** screen opens. [Show Me!](#)
